COVID-19 PROTECTION CONCEPT

Important information on the new coronavirus and the social distancing and hygiene rules.

Dear Players,

we have great pleasure to welcome you for the PENATI SLOVAK OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP 2020 which will be hosted from September 13 to 15 in the Penati Golf Resort.

For the smooth running of the event, we thank all participants to take note of the instructions below:

- Wearing the mask is mandatory during travel in the club house
- Every player has to sign document "attestation Covid" before using any of the golf or club-house facilities.
- All trolleys from the golf club will be disinfected before and after to use
- The appointed Corona officer: Mr. Radomír Holečka

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARTICIPANT

The following rules of hygiene must be observed:

- 1. Players with symptoms of illness do not play nor train.
- 2. Keep your distance: minimum 1.5 metres.
- 3. Wear masks if distance cannot be maintained.
- 4. Wash your hands regularly and thoroughly.
- 5. Avoid shaking hands.
- 6. Cough and sneeze into a tissue or into the crook of your arm.
- 7. Get tested in case of symptoms.
- 8. Provide contact information to enable tracking and tracing.
- 9. Comply with isolation and quarantine measures if you are sick.

All staff, players, officials, volunteers and visitors to the Championship must make every attempt to follow the specific sanitary and other infection prevention procedures communicated by the Championship committee and to act responsibly towards other at all times.

All people attending the Championship are doing so at their own risk, and knowing that Covid-19 infection and the possible consequences, which may include Championship cancellation, and quarantine, are part of that risk.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE OBSERVED DURING THE CHAMPIONSHIP:

- All participants need to fill in the **"Covid Declaration" form** before the start of the event. The document will have to be signed at the Registration Desk.



- Upon arrival at the club, give the name, address and telephone **number of your accompanying person/s** (caddie, parents, coach, friends, ...).
- Players must carry a small bottle of **disinfectant** in their golf bag.
- Players respect the maximum number of people allowed **indoors**: secretariat, restaurant, cloakrooms, scoring area, ...
- Players should not exchange any **objects** (umbrellas, tees, balls, score cards, ...)
- Players should clean their **equipment** with their own cloth.
- After **touching** the bunker rake, flagpole, distance and marking posts of the Penalty Areas as well as ball washers, players should disinfect their hands.
- Players will receive their **own scorecard** on the tee. They will be informed of who's score they are in charge of as marker. They should mark both scores on their own scorecard.
- At **recording**, players must check their score with their marker in front of the scoring official and markers must give their formal approval of the player's score verbally. The scoring official will record the formal approval of the markers. Players must then sign their scorecard and officially return it.
- Players should **avoid** shaking hands, "high-fives", kisses and hugs.
- Players should not be transported by the **referees**, e.g., to return to the start or last played position.

In case of disregard, the player may be expelled from the facility.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Opening ceremony: will be organized only if it is possible to organize it outside; if else, it will not take place.

Closing ceremony and prize-giving: in case of bad weather, an indoor ceremony will be organized only for the winner, second, third place-getters, and officials.

Caddie-Room: players are asked to bring their golf bag home / to the hotel every day, to avoid contacts in the caddie-room.

Lockers: Access will be possible only in case of emergency (space restrictions).

INFORMATION ON QUARANTINE

Anyone who may have become infected with the coronavirus must go into quarantine. If they fall ill, they should avoid all contact with others in order to prevent the spread of the virus. The quarantined person should stay at home or in some other suitable accommodation for ten (10) days and not leave for any reason.
