COVID-19 PROTECTION CONCEPT

Dear Players,

we have great pleasure to welcome you for the PENATI SLOVAK OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP 2021 which will be hosted from September 12 to 14 in the Penati Golf Resort.

Please find attached the <u>Official Invitation</u>, including the <u>Special Permission</u> letter allowing all Penati Slovak Open participants to cross the Slovak border at arrival, on this link: https://golfslovakopen.sk/turnaje/turnaj-2021/

In addition to these documents, and referring to current restrictions, you must bring with you <u>one of these certificates</u>:

- 1. A negative Covid19 test result taken not earlier than 72hours prior arrival **or**
- 2. A certificate of a full vaccine program, taken at least 14 days prior arrival **or**
- 3. A certificate having been infected by the Covid19 virus no longer than 6 months prior arrival

And of course you need to fulfill requirements of having all general documents for arrival (passport, possible visa etc).

Please do not forget to fill in the form when crossing the border:

Registration at arrival from abroad (https://korona.gov.sk/en/ehranica/)

Please note: In the permission letter is written that travel details are to be sent to the border control 24 hours prior arrival.

These details will be provided by the Promoter of tournament, not by each participant.

Important information on the coronavirus and the social distancing and hygiene rules.

For the smooth running of the event, we thank all participants to take note of the instructions below:

- Wearing the mask is mandatory during travel in the club house
- Every player has to fill in the entry form
- All trolleys from the golf club will be disinfected before and after to use
- The appointed Corona officer: Mr. Radomír Holečka

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARTICIPANT

The following rules of hygiene must be observed:

- 1. Players with symptoms of illness do not play nor train.
- 2. Keep your distance: minimum 1.5 metres.



- 3. Wash your hands regularly and thoroughly.
- 4. Avoid shaking hands.
- 5. Cough and sneeze into a tissue or into the crook of your arm.
- 6. Get tested in case of symptoms.
- 7. Comply with isolation and quarantine measures if you are sick.

All staff, players, officials, volunteers and visitors to the Championship must make every attempt to follow the specific sanitary and other infection prevention procedures communicated by the Championship committee and to act responsibly towards other at all times.

All people attending the Championship are doing so at their own risk, and knowing that Covid-19 infection and the possible consequences, which may include Championship cancellation, and quarantine, are part of that risk.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE OBSERVED DURING THE CHAMPIONSHIP:

- Upon arrival at the club, give the name, address and telephone **number of your accompanying person/s** (caddie, parents, coach, friends, ...).
- Players respect the maximum number of people allowed **indoors**: secretariat, restaurant, cloakrooms, scoring area, ...

In case of disregard, the player may be expelled from the facility.

INFORMATION ON QUARANTINE

Anyone who may have become infected with the coronavirus must go into quarantine. If they fall ill, they should avoid all contact with others in order to prevent the spread of the virus. The quarantined person should stay at home or in some other suitable accommodation for ten (10) days and not leave for any reason.
